

## Minimum Requirements:

- Computer: IBM-compatible PC, 486DX33\* minimum for half-screen video. Full-screen video requires Pentium processor, or 486DX66 with local bus video card or other hardware-based video accelerators.
- Operating System: Microsoft™ Windows 3.1 running DOS 5.0 or higher — Windows 95 compatible.
- Memory: 8 MB RAM (total system RAM; includes RAM required for Windows).
- Hard Disk: 5 MB free hard disk space.
- Video: SVGA video adapter supporting 640x480x256 color resolution and color monitor.
- Audio: Windows-supported sound card.
- CD-ROM Drive: MPC rated, 300 KB/sec "double speed" or higher transfer rate.
- Ancillary Software Requirements: MSCDEX 2.21 or higher.
- Supporting Software: QuickTime™ 2.0 for Windows (supplied with product).

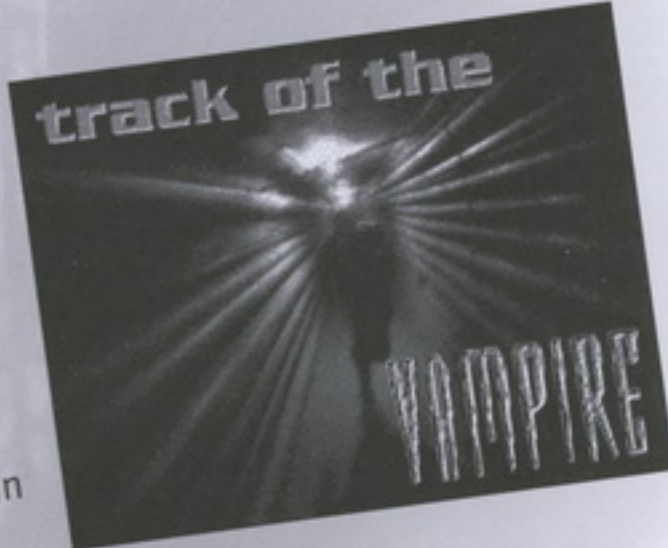

**F**irst there was the movies. Then there was television. Now there's something else. Imagine a thriller with a new twist each time you experience it. Imagine a mystery that is different with each pursuit. Imagine a dark corridor that beckons with another chance to confront, and maybe this time, defeat evil. Now turn on Terror T.R.A.X.

- You will be in command, but not necessarily in control. You will be in the middle of a changing story, full of shifting fortunes, elusive characters, and risky choices. But don't think of this as simply a game to win or lose. You may find out that the best way to survive is to die first.





## How to Play

All program commands in Terror T.R.A.X. are handled through keys on your keyboard, not the mouse.

A: Type "A" to choose option A displayed on your screen.

B: Type "B" to choose option B displayed on your screen.

If you don't make a choice, the program will make one for you.

Space Bar: Pause the program.

S: Save the program. Only the most recently saved program will be stored.

R: Restore the saved program at the beginning of the segment in which "S" was pressed.

X: Exit the program.

## Notes on Replay

### How Save and Restore operate

When you hit "Save", Terror T.R.A.X. records which segment of the program you are in. It will not prompt you

for a filename, or notify you that the save has been made as this would interrupt the flow of the program and you might miss important information.

If you hit "R," you will instantly return to the beginning of the segment in which you pressed "S." Experiment with this to get the feel of how it works.

## Strategy Hints

Save and Restore are useful because if your operative gets killed you can hit "R" to return to an earlier point in the program and try again. Hit "S" at each point where you feel you've made progress. If your operative is terminated at the next decision point, you can return to the previous scene quickly and get another chance.

If you type "X" and leave the program, Terror T.R.A.X. will remember where you last hit "S." When you restart the program, type "R" to immediately return to where you were.





### Using "A" and "B" to your best advantage

You have to make tough choices with the "A" and "B" buttons. If you don't hit them in time, the program will make the choice for you. If you want to debate the options, hit the SPACE BAR and you can pause to think about it.

### Replaying with "F"

If you have been through a segment before, and would like to skip forward, pressing "F" will advance you to the next story segment or decision point.

### Installation

1. Insert the CD-ROM with the label side up into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Run **D:\Setup.exe** (Where **D** is the letter for your CD-ROM drive.)
3. Follow the on-screen instructions in the installation program

When you reach a screen "Installation Successful",

Terror T.R.A.X. is now a new program group on your computer.

4. Click on the **QuickTime for Windows Installation Program Icon to Install QuickTime.**

The Terror T.R.A.X. program requires QuickTime for Windows in order to run. It is included on your CD-ROM. An icon will appear next to the Terror T.R.A.X. icon in the Terror T.R.A.X. program group. Click on the QuickTime Installer icon and follow the prompts.

If you don't see the QuickTime for Windows Installer Icon: Run **D:\qtw203\setup** (where **D** is the letter of your CD-ROM drive) and press Enter.

Follow the on-screen instructions.

5. Restart Windows
6. Start Terror T.R.A.X.

1. Open the Terror T.R.A.X. program group if it is not open.

2. Double-click on the Terror T.R.A.X. program icon.
3. The program will display the startup window.

If you click on the "Click here for small screen presentation" box, the program will appear in a smaller size on your screen. For some systems, this smaller size allows for faster video and audio.

Leaving the box blank will bring the program up in full-screen mode.

Each machine is different, so you'll need to do some experimenting to find which setting is best for you. Try the program with the large window first. If the performance is not to your liking, type "X" to exit the program. Restart the program and click on "Click here for small screen presentation." Then try the program in small-screen mode.

*A large screen works best with a Pentium or better. Generally, a 486DX33 will need the small screen. For other 486 computers, performance depends on the specific configuration of your system.*

Once you've found the setting you prefer, you can select the "Don't show this screen anymore" box.

### Reinstalling the Program to Change the Screen Size:

If you do need to re-install the program to return to the install window at some point, you DON'T need to re-install QuickTime again — just re-install Terror T.R.A.X. and the next time you play, the startup window will re-appear. This process takes only minutes.

### Achieving the Best Picture Quality (Optional)

Terror T.R.A.X. looks the best in thousands of colors. We recommend you reconfigure your system with this color depth, typically called 65,536 colors or High Color (Win 95), for best results.

Some systems will allow you to switch between 256 and 65,536 colors using an option within Windows.

Other systems may come with a program located on your Windows desktop that allows you to switch between the different color options.

Consult your hardware manuals for instructions on switching between 256 and thousands of colors, or call your hardware manufacturer's support line.

**NOTE: Terror T.R.A.X. may not run with Millions of colors (also known as True Color) settings.**

### **Disable your Screen Saver (Optional)**

Screen savers may appear during Terror T.R.A.X.

If you have a special screen saver program you may use its control program to disable it. Most screen savers are handled by Windows. Use Windows Help to get information on how to turn your screen saver off.
