## INSTALLING & STARTING THE GAME

**Windows® 95/98 & Macintosh® Customers:** No installation is required with the Windows 95/98 AutoPlay feature or Macintosh computer systems. Just insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive, wait for the AutoPlay screen and click the *Play* button (Win 95/98), or double click on the *Maze Madness* icon on your desktop (Macintosh).

**Windows® 3.1 Customers:** Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. Select the **Run...** command from the **File** menu in the Windows Program Manager. Type **D:\UNSTALL.EXE** (Replace "D" with your CD-ROM drive letter.) Click the Quick Install button and follow the on-screen instructions. The installation program will create a *Microcross* group in Program Manager. A *Maze Madness* icon will be placed in this group. Double click on the *Maze Madness* icon to start the game. You may need to click the **Re-start Windows** button the first time you play. **Note:** The installation of *Maze Madness* will take no more than 2.5 MB of hard disk space. You will need to insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive each time you play.

## SPACEBAR OPTIONS

Press the spacebar while playing *Maze Madness* to pause the game and to reveal the following option buttons: *Quit*, *Restart*, *Options* (technical information) and *Play*.

## HELP

**Windows Customers:** For online documentation and game hints just press the F1 key from within the game. Or, for troubleshooting tips and last-minute game information, see the readme file on your game CD.
