Installation

- Place the Golden Nugget CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive.
- The installation program should start automatically. Follow the on screen instructions. If Autorun is disabled, follow the steps listed below.
- In Windows® 95/98 Click on the **Start** button then select **Run**.
- In the **Run** line type **D:\setup**, where D:\ is you CD-ROM drive and click **OK**. Follow the on screen instructions.

Beginning the Game

To start the game, put the Golden Nugget CD-ROM in the drive and click on **Play**. If the Autorun is disabled, click on **Start, Programs, Virgin Interactive** and then **Golden Nugget for Windows 95**.

After viewing the limousine driving up the Las Vegas Strip and to the Golden Nugget, you'll be taken to the lobby where you'll see the **Registration Desk** on the right hand side of the screen. Click on the desk to bring up the **Guest Ledger**. You will need to sign the Guest Ledger to play and get your \$1,000 dollars and the 9 markers (each worth \$1,000) to gamble with.

Now you have the opportunity to choose between **Casino Play** (which is the default mode) and **Tournament** mode. *Note: the mode of the game which you enter now will be saved for whenever that game is loaded again.*

If you chose **Tournament**, clicking on **To Casino** now will bring you directly to the first of numerous full motion video vignettes. These will help unravel a mystery which you will be asked to solve in the Casino.

If you changed to **Casino Play** mode, clicking on **To Casino** will bring you to the **Navigation View**, which functions as your menu to select the gaming activities of your liking. You can also change your mind at any time about venturing into the Casino. Click on **Check Out** to exit the game.

*For Help at any time press the **F1** key on your keyboard.*

*Pressing **<esc>** at any time in the Navigation View quits the game and prompts you to save an unsaved game.*

*Pressing **<esc>** at any time within any of the games in the Casino, takes you back to the Navigation View.*

Loading a Saved Game

Later, when you come back to either start a new game (by clicking again on *New Game*) or to load a saved game, the ledger will indicate the mode of play each game was in, plus the amount of cash and credit you had when each game was last saved.

To load a saved game, click to the left of the desired name and hit **To Casino**. That game will be loaded (with the cash and credit amount indicated in the Ledger). If the loaded game is in Casino Play mode, you will be dropped into the area of the Casino in which you played last. If the loaded game was in Tournament mode, you will be taken to the point in the story at which you last left off.

Navigation View

Upon entering Casino Play mode, you will be presented with the Navigation Views of the various sections of the main Casino Floor. Clicking on the tables, or the signs bearing the various games' names above them, will take you directly to that game.

Clicking in the slots area, for example, will first give you a close-up view of the Slot machines, then you can choose the particular type of machine you want.

Moving the mouse cursor around on the carpet will cause signs to pop-up saying "turn left" or "turn right." Clicking on these will take you in the direction listed.

From the Navigation View, you can bring up the **Purse** by clicking on the oval **GN** logo in the bottom middle of the screen. Accessing the Purse from the Navigation Views is mainly for taking account of your current cash balance situation. You may want to check it carefully before deciding which game to play!

The Purse

When you are in a game, the Purse is used to select the denominations and amounts of chips, cash or coins to be bet at any of the gaming tables or machines. It varies in its makeup, depending on which game you're in.

Purse Features

- Total accumulated cash is shown in the **Total** window on the lower left of the screen.
- Your current bet amount is in the window to the right of the cash total window marked **BET**.
- The round area in the middle is called the Purse "**Tray**." This is where bets are stacked.
- A **V.I.P. Club** card will appear in the area on the right side of the Purse. You can become a V.I.P. Club member once you have reached a total of \$50,000. The card will allow you to enter the High Limit Games and High Limit Slots.
- Outstanding Keno tickets are stored for you automatically in the slot on the far right side of the Purse. (If you have tickets in the slot, you will know that there are still games on which you may be able to cash in your winnings!)
- When you run out of money completely, you will automatically be granted the cashing in of a marker. This will give you another \$1,000 to play with. When all 9 markers are depleted, the game ends and you will be returned to the Registration Desk.

The Purse's Asset Display

- For slots and Video Poker, assets are displayed as sliver coins.
- For Big Six, Keno and in Navigation Views, assets are displayed as sliver coins.
- For all card games and Craps, assets are displayed as a combination of coins and chips of various denominations.
- For Roulette, assets are displayed as the unique Roulette (nondenominational) chips.
